Give to the Community – Get Free Admission to TAP 2010

The Greater Houston Student Volunteer Initiative (formerly, White Oak) will donate funds to TAP when Klein Collins seniors perform community service in the Greater Houston Area. This is a charitable foundation formed by the local company White Oak Energy to promote community service by our area's youth. The White Oak Foundation will donate up to \$20,000 to TAP 2010 under the following conditions.

1. For every hour worked by a student, White Oak will donate \$10 to TAP, up to a limit of 10 hours per student. Parents *cannot* work in the place of their student.
2. A student must perform a minimum of 8 hours of community service to earn a free ticket to TAP. Any hours that do not meet the minimum will be forfeited and applied to the TAP general fund.
3. If a student performs more than 8 hours of community service, the additional monies generated (\$10 per student hour) will be placed in the TAP general fund.
4. Community service must be performed in no less than 3 consecutive hour blocks. (3, 4 and more consecutive hours will be accepted - 1 and 2 hours will not unless approved by a coordinator or with respect to a 2 hour block with the Emergency Aid Coalition.)
5. Community service hours are non-transferable. They only apply to the person who does the work.
6. This option is only available to Klein Collins 2010 seniors. Others wishing to attend TAP must pay the admission price.
7. Community service hours must be performed at approved locations (see attached list and web address). The goal is to help the Greater Houston Area. A student must get permission prior to performing community service at non-approved venues. Community service hours performed at the student's own school will not be accepted.
8. Community service hours must be unique to TAP. For example, a student may not get credit for performing the SAME community service (date and hours) for TAP and National Honor Society.

Instructions

1. For group activities, register with the Student Volunteer Coordinators by email.
2. For individual activities on the attached list and website, you do not need to register in advance with the Student Volunteer Coordinators; contact the organization directly to arrange to volunteer.
3. To set up a group activity or get a volunteer activity approved that is not listed, contact Susan Miller at KCHSTAP10@yahoo.com.
4. If you sign up – show up. Take the Record of Community Service Hours Form (attached) with you. Get it signed by the organization's coordinator before you leave.
5. Turn in the completed Record of Community Service Hours to one of the Student Volunteer Coordinators by April 1, 2010 in order to receive credit towards TAP. No form – no credit!
6. Get your hours turned in early... once KCHS reaches the \$20,000 limit, you will no longer have an opportunity to earn a free ticket to TAP.
