

# On-Line Grade Repair

## Parameters:

- Form must be signed by student and parent/guardian, then returned to Counselors' Office
- All tests and quizzes must be completed on campus
- Workroom open with teacher monitor:

- Students must be on time when attending monitored sessions
- With the successful completion of the on-line coursework, six-week grade changes will be 70 – 75 based on the cumulative average earned. Grade changes will not change a student's UIL eligibility.
- The window of time allowed to complete a six-week grade recovery segment will end at the completion of the following six weeks grading cycle
- Students participating in grade repair for on level courses must complete 80% of the program within the six weeks time frame
- Students enrolled in Pre-AP courses must complete 100% of the grade repair program within the six weeks time frame

## General Information:

- Pre-quiz for each lesson - passing score on pre-quiz to bypass the lesson must be 70 or higher
- If student needs to complete the lesson they will complete all of the assignments set within the program. Passing score on the quiz at the end of the lesson must be 70 or higher.
- If a student is not successful on the post-quiz they will be given a second opportunity on the quiz. If a student is not successful on the second post-quiz they will need to redo the lessons and assignments.
- Once a student has gone through the lesson a second time and has not successfully passed the quiz after two more opportunities the student will be removed from the program.
- Passing score on the cumulative exam must be 70 or higher for those students completing 100% of the program. Students will have two opportunities to take the cumulative exam before they will be assigned to redo the lessons and assignments.
- Six-week grade changes will be 70 – 75. The grade will be based on the cumulative average the student has once they have completed all of their coursework. A student will receive a grade change equal to their cumulative average if the average is between 70 & 74. If a student has a cumulative average of 75 or higher, they will receive a grade change of 75 for the six-weeks.
- All tests and quizzes must be completed on campus. Lessons, notes and assignments can be completed outside of campus.
